




# Main Project Components\*

\*Quantities shown here are based on Unit Price Bid Proposal

- 1. 64,481 CY of Excavation (incl. 7,377 CY of Over Excavation & approx. 18,000 CY of Disposal of Excess Material)
- 2. Installation of 3,532 CY of Class A, I 70 CY of Class B and 253 CY of Class H Riprap
- 3. I Reinforced Structural Ported Riser Structure
- 4. 3,002 CY of Shotcrete (8"thick) & 527 CY of Structural Concrete
- 5. 2,225' LF 5-strand Barbless Wire Fencing

# Staging & Dirt Disposal

### Staging

- SSCAFCA owns a large amount of property near the project site that can be used for staging.
- Contractor can work with private land owners to obtain access for staging, etc.

### Dirt Disposal

- SSCAFCA is working with a landowner adjacent to the project site to negotiate a dirt disposal location.
  - SSCAFCA will issue an addendum formalizing this, if it happens in time.
- Contractor should have an alternative dirt disposal location off the project site, in the event a local disposal site cannot be negotiated.
